A real old bloke came to see us with two stones that he had for eons (I think when Moses was a boy). The first is potch with a little colour on just about a full bar of gypsum sitting on sandstone. In the old days miners picked this potch up so that it could be used for backing of doublets and triplets, that's how old this stone is. It weighs 126oz, is a collector's item, in one corner it has a little bit of blues but it would go beautifully in a collector's cabinet for only \$465.

The old guy brought with him the largest piece of potch I have ever seen, in fact it weighs 138oz. There is one small piece that has come off the side, it weighs just over 8.5oz. There is a small water bar running through this piece, again this is for a collector I'm not saying it is the largest piece of potch and colour in the world but it is 50 years since I first walked onto the opal field and I have never seen such a large opal for only \$975. You will have a real collector's item.
